About the Summit

The first summit in 2016 brought together experts, stakeholders, and policy makers to prepare Georgia's first State Plan to Address Senior Hunger which was published in December 2017. The Third Annual Senior Hunger Summit will be held Oct. 16-17, 2018 at the Columbus Convention & Trade Center, 801 Front Ave., Columbus, GA 31901. The Summit's opening day coincides with World Food Day. Their global call to action this year is to end hunger by 2030, and we will answer that call by focusing our efforts to address hunger among older Georgians! This year's Summit will feature sessions that cover the five focus areas of the State Plan:

- Today's seniors
- Health impact of senior hunger
- Food access

- Food waste and reclamation
- Meeting the needs of the community
